Time Trials

The aim of the Time Trials is to navigate through a designated course around Canberra closest to a preset time. At Robbo's you will be given a card with your departure time. You will travel to the first checkpoint (a map will be provided) and have your arrival time recorded. Then on to the second and third checkpoints. After that you head to Black Mountain Peninsula for your final checkpoint, BBQ and Winners presentation.

THIS IS NOT A RACE!!!!

Remember to always practice safe motor cycling. Look after yourselves and others!!

Further Information:

- All preset times will be on or below the designated speed limit with prevailing Sunday traffic taken into account. (The fastest time is unlikely to be the winning time.)
- Only checkpoint position will be given, however the preset time will be determined using as direct a route as possible.
- Riders leave Robbo's at one minute intervals.
- You can check in at checkpoints and checkout immediately or have a rest/socialise, then checkout when you are ready.
- There will be water available at Checkpoint 2.
- The ride finishes at Black Mountain Peninsula.
- Set your own pace. You are able to pass others.

Winners Presentation

Prizes will be presented to:

- Overall Winner: The rider who completes the whole course closest to the preset time
- Four Section Winners: Those riders who complete a section closest to the preset time for that section.
- Four Mystery Time Winners: Those riders who come in closest to pre-decided mystery times.
