Directors Report:

 - Marie asked that the Secretary collect requests and submit to the committee.
 - Pia enquired about insurance and Marie advised that as we were not collecting fees for this, insurance would be covered by an individual's policy.
- Marie asked the members to submit any ride suggestions that they might have to the Secretary for consideration at the next Road Captains planning meeting.

Assistant Directors Report:

- Kiwi advised the committee that the cost of the dinner for the Saturday night at the National Rally would be between \$15 & \$20 for those who had not chosen the option for a meal on the Saturday night.

- Ralph provided a financial report for the Chapter as follows;

Safety Officer:

- Wobbly advised the meeting that two First Aid kits had been purchased for a total cost of \$85.50.
- There would be a register at the shop for the Road Captains to sign the kits in and out for rides. Any item in the kit that is used is to be recorded so that the Safety Officer can replenish the kits.

LOH:

- Pia advised that the LOH slow rider course has been booked for the 29th of November at the AFP training ground on Majura Road.
 - Cost will be \$150 pp based on 6 participants – some funding would be available from the Chapter
 - Dave Gibson from Stay Upright advised that if there are more than 6 participants another Stay Upright instructor will be required and not a CHOG Road Captain as initially planned.
 - Peter Henshaw is to provide a letter from the AFP with permission to use the facilities for the day.
 - Any participants will be required to provide personal details to the AFP for checking prior to being let on the premises.
- Pia advised that the run that was scheduled for Crisp Gallery on the 13th of September has been moved to the Pancake Parlour at Bredbo at 1000 at Robbo's for a departure of 1030.
- Pia advised that the theme for the National Rally this year would be Disco.
- Next Ladies Garage Night will be held at Robbo's on the 24th of September.
